This year we had a number of players selected in state train on squads in juniors, seniors and veterans and congratulations to all those players. Umpire Director's Report

The Board of Management organized a Promotion Night at the beginning of the season where Information was disseminated in regards to the Role of the Umpires Director and possible directions for 2010.

Foremost was the initial meeting of the Umpires Committee where they discussed various concerns and suggested ways in which MVHA may improve the umpiring situation.

The Umpires Committee organized 2 Umpiring Seminars, 1 for the Juniors and I for the Seniors, both of which were reasonably well attended.

My thanks to Marlene Masters for her time and effort in compiling the information for the brochures that were distributed at these seminars and are available for all in the clubhouse.

The committee also -

Produced Guidelines for Umpires to assist them with the awarding of Best and Fairest points in a game.

Suggested that payment for Umpire travel be capped at \$20 per game.

Requested umpires still to wear the black uniform introduced last year and also official umpire shirts (Lime green) may also be worn.

Stated that allocation of umpires each week was the responsibility of each sub-committee

The Junior Umpire Committee was very active in developing their young umpires, allocating them to games each week, assisting them with knowledge of the basic rules -how to interpret and apply them, initiating testing to achieve local accreditation and by supplying bright orange umpiring shirts purchased with the support of a sponsor.

Again, many thanks to Marlene and her small band of helpers, who saw the project through:

It is encouraging to see many umpires adopt a sincere and positive attitude to the teams when they umpire.

It is also vital for umpires to be more assertive in their control and discipline of the game to eliminate inappropriate behaviour and offensive language.

Unfortunately there were several red cards issued during the season and due to a technicality during my absence these were not acted upon.

However 1 do acknowledge the individual clubs that did deal with these in an appropriate manner. Hockey NSW issued Judiciary Guidelines this year and the BOM will be endeavouring to incorporate these into their Judicial Policy.

2010 saw some modifications to self- play hit rule, which did not cause major problems, and also the introduction of-

The 2 minute green card rule

Breaking the lines at Penalty' Corners.

Both these rules were introduced early in the season and thus made for easy transition for representative players in their respective teams. Many thanks to all those who dedicated

their services to the teams throughout the season as umpires and for the commitment they showed in their weekly duties.

Also thanks to umpires who traveled with representative teams to fulfill these roles and also to those who were available to umpire the Finals series in the Juniors, Womens and Mens divisions.

Nominations were called for from the three sub committees to submit names and a critique for the award for 'Umpire of the Year'. It was pleasing to see the response this year and the worthy recipient was Marlene Masters. Congratulations on such a great job throughout the season and especially win all the additional work with the Junior Committee.

With the work continuing this year in our Juniors I hope that this support continues for those who aspire into becoming an umpire and also encourage others to become more familiar with the rules and play a more active role in practical umpiring next season.

Promotion Director's Report

2010 proved to be another busy year for publicity and promotion of Hockey in the Manning Valley Region. With the new turf set to function for it's first full season, the aim was to bring in as many new players to the sport as possible.

In order to promote hockey to children across our region, Alan Steere and his band of helpers visited a number of schools in the area early in the year. These visits helped draw a number of new junior players into various clubs.

We continued to promote our sport through the very successful Small Schools Sports Day, which was held in May. Once again this gave the opportunity for children in outlying schools to participate in organised coaching with children their own age.

"Minkey" was promoted for 3-7 year olds once again this year. Run each Saturday morning by Marlene Masters, the program saw 24 children participate this year. Many of these will go into under 7 teams next year, a very successful outcome.

Our sport was highlighted in the community when Manning Valley hosted the under 15 girls half state championships. The Championships received coverage from the Manning River Times, Prime and NBN.

Prime news came to record the final in which The Manning Valley 1 Team were runners up, whilst in the division 2, the Manning Valley 2 team won the championship. The Manning River Times then provided a write up together with photos of the event.

We also hosted the Under 13's Boys and Girls Hunter Conference, which was supported and promoted by The Manning River Times. Both these events proved very successful for our Association, and they highlighted the importance of our sport within the community.

Weekly Hockey reports continued to feature in our local paper every week, usually on Wednesdays, with thanks to the Junior Publicity Officer Bronwyn Fuller, the Men's Publicity Officer Adam Birkefeld and Women's Publicity Officer Marlene Masters. These reports were complimented by photographs taken by the Times photographer.

There were many local businesses who helped contribute to the success of our sport by sponsorship of various representative teams, Bunnings, Yates Garden Products and Workwise Clothing just to name a few. We appreciate the help given to our teams this year.






