Open Men Field State Championship 9th – 11th June to be held at Moorebank

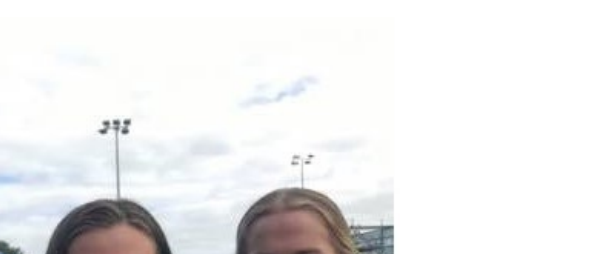
Open Women Field State Championship – 9th – 11th June to be held at Narellan
