An update from our July Board of Management Meeting held 28th July 2014 and other meetings.

1. Coolroom for club house Canteen.

2. Tenders for Contract Cleaner

No tenderts have been received for cleaning the clubhouse. We may have to employ commercial cleaners twice a year to do a thorough clean.

3. Soap Dispensers for Toilets

4. Expression of interest to host State Tournaments.

Hockey NSW has change the way state touraments are allocated. Associations now have to tender for them and the successful tender is for three years. The association and GTCC are putting in a tender and our preference is for Under 15 Boys Tournament.

5. I Pads

The association has purchased two for use for training umpires and for coaching. The President has hem at the moment.

6. Hooter on scoreboard at TLF Field.

We have been in contact with Ausportsnregarding the problem with the hooter. They want over \$900 to come down from Port to fix it. We will try some suggestions first, We will purchase a new computer aerial as someone has crimped it on the lid of the strorage box.
