

2014 October NEWSLETTER

An update from our October 2014 Board of Management Meeting held on the 22nd October and other information.

1. 2014-15 Centre of Development Program (COD)

The program aims to provide high level coaching and development for athletes of all skill levels. The Centre of Development is designed for both genders and is open to athletes U13 and U15 in 2015. The Centre of Development Program will be utilised as a selection tool for the 2015 Under 15 Boys and Girls State Team and Blues Team. This is due to the 2015 Hockey Australia Calendar, with the U15 Nationals being scheduled during April prior to the Hockey NSW Field State Championships. Whilst this program will be utilised as a selection process and is a significant part of the pathway, attendance is not compulsory for athletes in this age group to be eligible for these teams.

The Centre of Development Program will be running from 10th November 2014 - 14th February 2015. Each region will have designated training times to fit in with turf and coach availability. Taree is Friday afternoons and Port are travelling to Taree . Manning Valley and Port Macquarie Hastings Hockey Association, are providing the turf free of charge

2. The MVHA Athlete Development and High Performance Coaching Programs.

The programs are up and running and Dylan is very pleased with the response both from our member coaches and player participation. Dylan has organised Woolies toi supply fruit platters for the players. He also has a Facebook Page devoted to information about the program.

8.NSW State Government Sport Facility Program for grants up to \$25,000.00

We have obtained a quote for extention to the safety fencesa at both turf and have applied for funding under the above grants to complete the works. Again we will have to wait and see if we are successful.

10. Cool room
