Alan was a tireless worker for hockey in this area and was loved and respected by a large number of past and present members of the hockey fraternity. He was an active member of the Manning Valley Hockey Association for more than 30 years and undertook numerous roles on its junior sub committee, women's sub committee and on the board of management. Alan was always "our go to man" when the association needed something done.

Alan held many management positions including promotions director and coaching director for Manning Valley Hockey. He was also a State selector for women and girls during his long involvement with hockey in the State. He held a state umpires badge and umpired State League matches when it was functioning.

Alan coached many teams for Chatham, Sharks, Wingham Hockey Clubs and Manning Valley. In 1997 Alan fulfilled his dream of forming his own club, Sharks, and

since the club has grown to now fielding 30 teams. He was the current club president.

Alan was awarded life memberships of both Sharks Hockey Club and Manning Valley Hockey Association in recognition of his contribution to hockey in Taree.

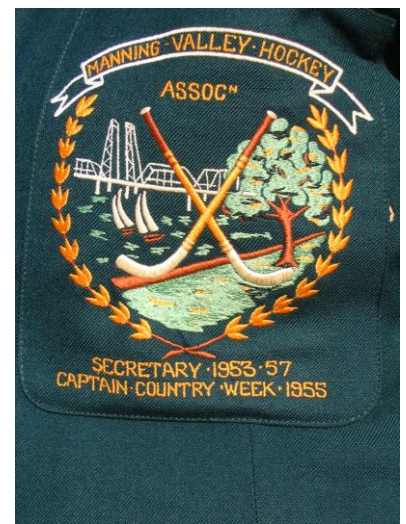



Only one seminar to discuss rules was held during the season and I thank Dylan Turner and his assistants for organizing this.

Copies of new rules, interpretations and Directions to Umpires were distributed to all clubs early in April. These were to be made available for all umpires and coaches and those interested in developing their knowledge of the game further.

Early in May a Special Meeting was held where new guidelines for implementation into the MVHA Judiciary Rules and Procedures Policy were discussed. These were adopted and now bring our procedures up to date with current NSW policy.

The Junior umpires have progressed with their knowledge and control of the game. During the season some of the juniors received advice and assistance from myself as well as other senior umpires. It was particularly encouraging to see many of our Juniors given the nod to officiate major games during the finals series.

It is encouraging to see many umpires adopt a sincere and positive attitude to the teams when they umpire and adopting a more assertive approach in their control and discipline of the game in an effort to eliminate inappropriate behaviour and offensive language.

During the season there were 4 Judiciary Hearings and 1 Investigative Hearing. Thanks to members of the panels for their time and expertise in deciding the outcomes.

I would like to acknowledge and congratulate the individual clubs now taking a stance with their players with regards to inappropriate behaviour as it is certainly getting the message across and with such a stance it will help to alleviate problems on the field and reduce the need for Judiciary hearings.

Congratulations to Gemma Turner who was invited to umpire at the National Under 15's Girls Tournament held in Sydney in October. I believe Gemma performed very well.

Congratulations also to Dylan Turner who was the very worthy recipient of the award for Umpire of the Year.

Many thanks to all those who dedicated their services to the teams throughout the season as umpires and for the commitment they showed in their weekly duties.

Also thanks to umpires who traveled with representative teams to fulfil these roles and also to those who were available to umpire the Finals series in the Juniors, Womens and Mens divisions.

Finally thank you to all who assisted me in my Role this year and to the BOM for assuming my duties whilst I was away with Australian and NSW commitments.

I look forward to a productive and positive season in 2012 and hope to see more active involvement from all players in the umpiring role.
